Admission Schedule

There are three semesters in every year - Spring, Summer and Fall. A candidate should apply in prescribed form available in the admission office of the university. The filled-in application form along with the necessary documents should be submitted to the Admission Office within the notified date.

Application Form

Students interested in taking admission to FIU should procure admission materials from the Admission Office and return the filled in Application Forms along with supporting documents to the Admission Office. Necessary documents to be attached with the completed Application Form.

Admission announcements are typically made a month before the beginning of the next semester. Usual dates for Admission for three semesters are: (i) Spring: end of November, (ii) Summer: end of March, and (iii) Fall: end of July. Check <https://www.fiu.edu.bd/> for admission notices.

Foreign Students

Applicant must produce a minimum IELTS score of 6.0 or any document that he/she is capable of continuing study at the FIU. For under-graduation programs, he/she must have proof that he/she has completed 12 years at the school level. He/she should also have proof of sufficient financial support in hand. Certificates, transcripts, and other required documents for admission should be in English or Translated in to English (notarized). Special provision of admission for foreign students will be either based on admission test or based on their school results. Foreign students should contact the Registrar office before planning for admission.

Credit Transfer

Students studying at other reputed public or private universities in Bangladesh or elsewhere in the world can transfer their credit to FIU accordingly as per FIU rule. Rules on credit transfer are available from the Admissions Office.

Financial Aid

Financial assistance from 25% to 100% of tuition fee waiver available in the following categories:

- Based on previous academic attainment and Admission Test result (Merit based Scholarship).
- Based on high academic attainment at FIU (Merit based tuition waiver).
- Based on financial NEED of a student (Waiver on Humanitarian grounds).
- Based on financial need & merit (Merit-Need based waiver).
- Based on two or more siblings studying together at FIU (Waiver for Siblings).

Minimum Requirements for Undergraduate Programs Admission

- A Minimum GPA 2.50 or 2nd division both in SSC and HSC examinations or equivalent, or at least one GPA of 2.00 but an aggregate GPA of 6.00 in SSC and HSC (or one 3rd division and one 1st division).
- O-Level in minimum 5 subjects with a GPA 2.50 and A-Level in 2 subjects with a minimum GPA2.00.
- Other 12 years equivalent degree (must have the equivalence certificate from Ministry of Education)
- Engineering Students must have Math and Physics in their H.S.C. with at least GPA2.00.

Minimum Requirements for Graduate Programs Admission

- The terms & conditions of undergraduate programs mentioned above will be applicable for admission to graduate programs.
- A relevant undergraduate degree from a recognized university with a GPA of 2.00 or above in a scale of 4.0, or a minimum 3rd class.
- Applicants without a Science group in HSC or equivalent level will not be considered for admission in any FIU MS (Masters) programs of the Faculty of Science and Faculty of Engineering.
- Students completing undergraduate programs from FIU having a minimum CGPA of 2.00 will be eligible to get admission to any graduate programs.
- Different departments may have some additional requirements.
- Some students may be required to complete some additional preparatory courses at FIU before they start their Master's programs.

PROGRAM BASED ELIGIBILITIES

Faculty of Business

Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

General Student: Students having a combined GPA of 5.0 in S.S.C and H.S.C with minimum 2.5 in each or total GPA of 6.00* with minimum GPA of 2.00 either in S.S.C or in H.S.C. or any equivalent background with a minimum "C" grade in English from any group may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects and at least two A- level subjects may apply. Out of these 7 subjects, applicants must have minimum 4 "B" grade 3 "C" grade.

Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management (BTHM)

General Student: Students having a combined GPA of 5.0 in S.S.C and H.S.C with minimum 2.5 in each or total GPA of 6.00* with minimum GPA of 2.00 either in S.S.C or in H.S.C. or any equivalent background with a minimum "C" grade in English from any group may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects and at least two A- level subjects may apply. Out of these 7 subjects, applicants must have minimum 4 "B" grade 3 "C" grade.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

Students having a minimum 2.50 GPA among in SSC and HSC and graduation from any group like BBA, B.Com Hon's, BA, B.Sc, M.Com, MA, M.Sc, MBBS or any equivalent background may apply for admission.

Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA)

- Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA among in SSC and HSC and graduation from any group like BBA, B.Com Hon's, BA, B.Sc, M.Com, MA, M.Sc, MBBS or any equivalent background may apply for admission.
- The EMBA Program aims at empowering corporate executives by enabling them to skillfully use theoretical knowledge in practical situations and take effective decisions. Participants with at least 3 years of working experience at the executive level are required.

Faculty of Liberal Arts & Social Science

Bachelor of Arts (Hons.) in English

General Student: Students having a combined GPA of 5.0 in S.S.C and H.S.C with minimum 2.5 in each or total GPA of 6.00*with minimum GPA of 2.00 either in S.S.C or in H.S.C. or any equivalent background with a minimum "C" grade in English from any group may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects and at least two A- level subjects may apply. Out of these 7 subjects, applicants must have minimum 4 "B" grade & 3 "C" grade.

Master of Arts in English

General Student: The students who have previously obtained BA (Hon's) in English from any recognized University are eligible to get admission in MA (Final) English with second class or CGPA 2.5.

Bachelor of Arts (Hons.) in Islamic Studies

General Student: Minimum two second divisions or one first division and one-third division or 4 CGPA in S.S.C/ Dakhil and H.S.C/ Alim or equivalent examinations. Students having break of study may apply.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects and at least two A- level subjects may apply. Out of these 7 subjects, applicants must have minimum 4 "B" grade & 3 "C" grade.

Master of Arts (Preli /Final) in Islamic Studies

General Student: Students seeking admission MA in Islamic Studies must have a bachelor degree from any recognized University at home or abroad with a minimum of third class or CGPA 2.0.

Faculty of Science

Bachelor of Science in Physics

General Student: The students with S.S.C. and H.S.C. background must have at least 2nd Division in both the exams (S.S.C. and H.S.C.) separately. And under CGPA system must have at least a minimum CGPA of 3.00 in both exams separately. Students entering the Bachelor of Science in Physics program for a B.Sc.in Physics degree must have completed SSC and HSC with Science.

For Diploma Holder: Students having a minimum 3.00CGPA both in SSC (Science) and Diploma may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: The students with 0-Level and A-Level must have an average grade of B. Students entering the Bachelor of Science in Physics program for a B.Sc. in Physics degree, must have completed O' Level (Five subjects including Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) and A' Level (with three major subjects - Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics).

Master of Science in Chemistry (M.Sc.in Chemistry)

- The students with S.S.C. and H.S.C. background or equivalent level of education must have at least 2nd Division or CGPA 2.5 in both the exams separately. If any exam has a minimum CGPA of 2.00, both exams must have a total CGPA of at least 6.00.
- The students with 0-Level and A-Level must have an average grade of B. For O Level (Five subjects including Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics) and A Level (with three major subjects- Physics, Chemistry, & Mathematics), and BSc Honors in Chemistry are eligible for admission.
- The students having B.Sc. in Chemistry with 3 years honors/pass (2 or 3 years) Degree must have at least a 2nd Division and students having B.Sc. in Chemistry with 4 years honors must have at least a 3rd Division or CGPA of 2.00.
- Applicants who have earned 4 years BS/ BSc (Hons)/ BSc Engineering from public/private universities must have minimum CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00, are eligible for admission.
- Applicants with four (4) years of graduation in Chemistry/ Chemical Technology/ Applied Chemistry/ Biochemistry/ Environmental Chemistry/ Industrial Chemistry/ Food Science (with Chemistry)/ Biological science (with Chemistry)/ Pharmacy/ Physics (with Chemistry)/ Geology (with Chemistry)/ Soil, Water & Environmental Science (with Chemistry)/ Chemical Engineering/ Micro Biology (with Chemistry)/ Genetic Engineering (with Chemistry) /Biotechnology (with Chemistry)/ Textile Engineering (with Chemistry)/ Lather Engineering & Technology (with Chemistry) or Chemistry related four (4) years honors, or three (3) years honors and one(1) year masters, or equivalent degree are eligible for admission.

Master of Science in Soil, Water & Environment

- Candidates must have a four-year Bachelor's Degree in relevant disciplines. Or candidates having a 2-year Master Degree or 3-year Bachelor Degree in the relevant disciplines may also apply. But they will need to do register for specified pre-requisite courses of at least 18 credits as recommended by the Curriculum Committee of the Department and approved by the Academic Council of the University.
- The applicant must not have third division/ class or CGPA less than 2.50 in the scale of 5.00 or CGPA 2.25 in the scale of 4.00 in any public examinations.

Master of Public Health (MPH)

- Graduate having M.B.B.S.B.D.S.M.D. Graduate Physiotherapist, B.H.M.S.B.A.M.S or Equivalent degree. The doctor must have to be registered with Bangladesh medical and Dental Council/ National Registration Authority.
- Graduation in Nursing, Health Technology, Nutrition, Health Science, Social Science, Anthropology, and Economics.
- Graduation in any discipline with work experiences (minimum 1 year) in a health related organization with grade point average of 2.5 or more on a scale of 4.0 from science or any equivalent background.
- Three-year or four-year bachelor degree with at least a second class in anthropology, psychology and social sciences. Students other than medical graduated may required to appear before Medical Background Examination Committee to prove their understanding about human health and diseases. They may require taking additional preparatory courses at FIU even after qualifying the test.

Faculty of Law

Bachelor (Hons.) of Laws–LLB

General Student: Minimum GPA 2.5 or 2nd Division in both SSC and HSC.

English Medium Student: A Level or successful completion of twelve years of studies at high school from abroad or equivalent.

Master of Laws-LLM

General Student: Candidates seeking admission in LL.M. (one-year program) should have at least LL.B. degree from any recognized university with second class or CGPA 2.50 from all levels.

English Medium Student: The students with O-Level and A-Level must have an average grade of B.

Faculty of Engineering

Bachelor of Science in Civil & Environmental Engineering

General Student: Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA or second division both in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC), or 12 class passed from Science or Equivalent may apply for admission.

For Diploma Holder: Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA both in SSC and Diploma from Civil Engineering and Architecture may apply for admission. Those having Diploma engineering are also eligible for application with waivers in some courses depending on their major and courses undertaken during the diploma.

English Medium Student: The O-level and A-level students must have an average grade of ' B'. The applicants must have Physics and Mathematics both at O-level and A-level.

Provision for Foreign Students: For other foreign certificates, the University will determine equivalence. Applicants will be required to sit for an admission test designed to judge their abilities and aptitude for the program.

Bachelor of Science in Computer Science & Engineering

General Student: Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA or 2nd Division both in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) 12 class passed Equivalent from Science, with minimum grade in Physics, Mathematics and English may apply for admission.

For Diploma Holder: Students having Polytechnic Diploma in a related programs (CSE/EEE/CSIT) with a minimum 2.5 GPA both in SSC & Diploma may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects (including Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) and at least two A-level subjects may apply. The applicants must have Physics and Mathematics both at O-level and A-level. The students with O-Level and A-Level must have an average grade of B.

Master of Science in Computer Science & Engineering (M.Sc.in CSE)

Applicants must satisfy anyone of the following criteria:

1. 4-years B.Sc. (or 3-years Honors + 1-year M.Sc.) in CS/CSE/IT/EEE/ECE/ETE or equivalent.
2. B.Sc. (Engineering) in any discipline with at least 1-year PGD in CSE/IT or equivalent.
3. 4-years B.Sc. (or 3-years Honors + 1-year M.Sc.) in Physics /Mathematics/ Statistics/ Geological Sciences/Chemistry/ Environmental Science.
4. CGPA of 2.5 or above (in a scale of 4.0), or at least second class in the B.Sc., and must have at least 2nd division or GPA 2.5 in SSC and HSC.

Bachelor of Science in Electrical & Electronic Engineering

General Student: Students having a minimum 3.00 GPA or 2nd Division both in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) 12 class passed from Science or Equivalent, with minimum grade in Physics, Mathematics and English may apply for admission.

For Diploma Holder: Students having Polytechnic Diploma in a related programs (Electrical/ Electronics/ Computer/ Telecommunication/ Power/Mechanical) with a minimum 3.00 GPA both in SSC and Diploma may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects (including Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) and at least two A-level subjects may apply. The applicants must have Physics and Mathematics both at O-level and A-level. The students with O-Level and A-Level must have an average grade of B.

Bachelor of Science in Textile Engineering

General Student: Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA both in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) 12 class passed from Science or Equivalent may apply for admission.

For Diploma Holder: Students having a minimum 2.5 GPA in SSC and 2.00 CGPA in Diploma from Textile Technology or Garments Design & Pattern Making (GDPM) technology may apply for admission

English Medium Student: Students completing five O-level subjects and at least two A-level subjects may apply. Out of these 7 subjects, applicants must have a minimum 4 'B' grade & 3 'C' grade.

Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch)

General Student: Students having a minimum 2.5GPA or 2nd division both in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC), or 12 class passed from Science or Equivalent may apply for admission.

For Diploma Holder: Students having minimum CGPA 2.50 in SSC with science group and Diploma from Polytechnic Institute (Architecture/Civil) may apply for admission.

English Medium Student: The O-level and A-level students must have an average grade of 'B'. The applicants must have five subjects including Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for O' Level and A' Level (with three major subjects - Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics).
